

**CITY OF HOLLADAY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2012-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2.14.040 AND 2.14.050 PERTAINING TO  
ELIGIBILITY OF MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL IN THE  
UTAH STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, present City personnel policies allow the Mayor and/or Members of the City Council to participate in the Utah Retirement System; and

**WHEREAS**, the Utah State Legislature has modified the eligibility requirements for elected and appointed officials who take office after July 1, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, present City personnel policies are contrary to said amendments; and

**WHEREAS**, modifications to these provisions is necessary.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Holladay City Council that Section 2.14.040 of the Code of Ordinances be amended to read as follows:

**2.14.040: SALARY OF CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS:**

- A. Compensation: The biweekly base compensation of the City Council Members shall be four hundred forty dollars (\$440.00) (\$11,440.00 annually). Members of the City Council may also elect to use their salary to participate in benefits offered by the City such as medical, dental and group life insurance and Section 125 Plan, subject to the rules and regulations thereof.
- B. Reimbursement For Expenses: Members of the City Council shall also receive reimbursement for all reasonable expenses related to the performance of their duties, including, but not limited to, mileage allowance in the same amount allowed by the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to Section 162 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- C. Benefits: Benefits shall also be provided to members of the City Council for noncontributory retirement and life insurance in the same manner, if any, provided to full time City employecs. (1999 Code) An individual newly appointed or newly elected as a City Council Member after July 1, 2011, is not eligible for participation in the Utah Retirement System.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ALSO ORDAINED** by the Holladay City Council that Section 2.14.050 of the Code be amended to read as follows:

**2.14.050: SALARY OF MAYOR:**

- A. Compensation: The biweekly base compensation of the Mayor shall be one hundred sixty percent (160%) of an individual Council Member's compensation or seven hundred four dollars (\$704.00) (\$18,304.00 annually).
- B. Voluntary Benefit Participation: The Mayor may also elect to use the salary to participate in benefits offered by the City such as medical, dental and group life insurance and Section 125 Plan subject to the rules and regulations thereof.
- C. Reimbursement For Expenses: The Mayor shall also receive reimbursement for all reasonable expenses related to the performance of their duties, including, but not limited to, mileage allowance in the same amount allowed by the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to Section 162 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- D. Benefits: Benefits shall also be provided to the Mayor for non-contributory retirement and life insurance in the same manner, if any, provided to full time City employees, including the use of a cellular telephone. (Ord. 04-01, 1-5-2004) An individual newly appointed or newly elected as Mayor after July 1, 2011, is not eligible for participation in the Utah Retirement System.


