In consideration of City of Holladay issuing this permit, the undersigned agrees that:

The above work shall be completed within 60 DAYS from the date hereon or as extended in writing by the City Engineer. All work shall be in accordance with applicable City Ordinances and State laws to the lines and grades approved by the City Engineer, and in accordance with specifications and inspection, and using materials approved by the City Engineer. If the work is not accomplished in accordance with these terms, the City may elect to correct the deficiencies and cause the holder to be liable for expenses incurred by the City.

The holder to this permit shall pay the cost of necessary alterations to existing improvements or required new facilities, including all irrigation and flood control requirements.

All City properties including, but not limited to, highway and sidewalk surfaces, curb and gutter, and drainage structures shall be restored to their original condition as existed before the work on this permit.

Existing concrete or asphalt surfacing shall be joined to street improvements by constructing adequate road base and matching surfacing in accordance with City specifications. Any cutting of existing surfacing shall be done in a workmanlike manner leaving well defined edges by using accepted construction practices.

If grading and/or earthwork construction on adjoining private property is required as a result of the improvement construction, the holder of this permit shall obtain a grading permit from Holladay City Community Development prior to construction. Telephone 272-9450, Attn: Community Development staff.

Any driveway must lead to an approved parking location.

The holder of this permit will be responsible for the safety of lives and property of users of roadways by using proper barricades, lights, flagmen and other appurtenances as required in the manual of uniform traffic control devices.

The holder of this permit shall indemnify the City for all losses, damages, or liability incurred or suffered by the City due to intentional or negligent acts or omissions caused by the holder.

If the improvement is to be placed on State right of way, prior to construction, the holder shall obtain a permit from the Utah Department of Transportation at 2060 South 2400 West Street, Telephone 975-4810.

The holder shall notify the Community Development staff concerning all proposed relocations of utilities prior to any construction. Telephone 272-9450, Attn: Community Development staff.

The Community Development Services shall be notified not less than 24 hours before concrete, asphalt or gravel is placed. Telephone 272-9450, Attn: Community Development staff.
