

Construction Activities: Friday, September 2 – Friday, September 6, 2016*

**Construction schedules are subject to change due to utility, material, weather and equipment delays.*

6200 South Bridge over I-215

- Beginning Tuesday, September 6 at 7 a.m., 6200 South will be reduced to one lane in each direction and will continue through Thursday, September 9 as crews begin maintenance on the 6200 South bridge over I-215
- Motorists can expect traffic restrictions on 6200 South under the I-215 bridge and are encouraged to plan ahead for traffic delays and be alert when traveling through the construction zone
- For motorists exiting the Old Mill Corporate Center, please consider an alternate route such as traveling Southbound on 3000 East to Fort Union Blvd.

700 East over I-215

- Crews will begin bridge maintenance on the 700 East bridge over I-215
- Motorists and cyclists can expect narrow lanes both northbound and southbound while maintenance is being performed
- Please use caution and be alert
- The 700 East bridge over I-215 will be closed for bridge maintenance activities beginning Friday, September 9 at 8 p.m. through Monday, September 12 at 6 a.m. Please plan ahead and find an alternate route.
- Surrounding residents and businesses can expect construction activities during the day and nighttime hours, traffic restrictions, construction equipment and vehicles in the area, and an increase in noise, dust and vibration.

I-215 Bridge over Tolcate Lane (5800 South)

- Pardon our noise as crews will begin bridge maintenance on the I-215 bridge over Tolcate Lane (5800 South) as early as September 9 and continue through September 12.
- Surrounding residents and businesses can expect construction activities during the day and nighttime hours, traffic restrictions, construction equipment and vehicles in the area, and an increase in noise, dust and vibration.

Holladay Blvd. under I-215

- Holladay Blvd. under I-215 continues to be closed to vehicle traffic and will remain closed through November for bridge maintenance activities
- Cyclists and pedestrians will be guided under the bridge by flaggers
- Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, use caution and be alert when traveling through the construction zone

I-215; one mile north and south of the 6200 South (Exit 6)

- The crossover is now in place and all traffic is shifted to the northbound side of I-215 in this area through late September
- In this area, I-215 is restricted to two lanes in each direction through late September
- Speeds have been reduced in this area. Please follow the posted speed limit as fines double for speeding in the construction zone.
- Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, follow the posted speed limit and be alert when traveling through the construction zone

Southbound/westbound on-ramp at the 6200 South exit (Exit 6)

- Shoulder work on the southbound/westbound on-ramp at 6200 South (Exit 6) begins continues as crews perform ramp maintenance
- Motorists can expect construction vehicles and equipment adjacent to the travel lane
- The ramp will remain open during this activity

Northbound/eastbound on-ramp at the 6200 South exit (Exit 6)

- Shoulder work on the on the northbound/eastbound on-ramp at 6200 South (Exit 6) continues as crews perform ramp maintenance
- Motorists can expect construction vehicles and equipment adjacent to the travel lane
- Ramp will remain open during activity
